## How To Find A Word/Phrase On A Page

#### Chrome

Hold down the CTRL key and press the F key

Or

Click on the top right corner where you will see 3 vertical dots: i and select Find

Type in the word/phrase you want to find on the page. The word/phrase (if it exists on the page) will be highlighted. Use the up and down arrows to move from one instance of the word/phrase to another.

#### Internet Explorer

Hold down the CTRL key and press the F key

Type in the word/phrase you want to find on the page. The word/phrase (if it exists on the page) will be highlighted. Use the Previous and Next buttons to move from one instance of the word/phrase to another.

### *Firefox*

Hold down the CTRL key and press the F key

Or

Click on the top right corner where you will see 3 vertical lines ≡ and select Find In This Page

Type in the word/phrase you want to find on the page. The word/phrase (if it exists on the page) will be highlighted. Use the up and down arrows to move from one instance of the word/phrase to another.

#### Safari

Hold down the Command key and press the F key

Type in the word/phrase you want to find on the page. The word/phrase (if it exists on the page) will be highlighted. Use the Previous and Next buttons to move from one instance of the word/phrase to another.

#### Edge

Hold down the CTRL key and press the F key


Or

Click on the top right corner where you will see 3 horizontal dots: " and select Find
